Proposed Enrolment Scheme and School Zone for Glenview Primary School

Background information

- With the development of the Peacocke block, the Ministry of Education requires Glenview to be able to manage its student numbers. This requires the introduction of an enrolment scheme and a school zone.
- It is intended that the school zone will take effect at the start of Term 4.
- Current student numbers at Glenview School are already close to maximum capacity.
- There are two primary schools planned within the Peacocke block, the first of which will likely be completed between 2025-2030.
- The procedures around school zones, how they are managed, and how out-of-zone children are prioritised, are laid out in the Education Act (1989).

If your child is currently at Glenview school

Any child who is attending Glenview School at the time the school zone commences, even if you live outside the school zone, has a guaranteed slot at Glenview through to the end of Year 6. None of the current students at Glenview are affected by the introduction of the school zone. The introduction of the school zone only affects new enrolments.

Future enrolments and priorities

Any future child living within zone

Any child who lives within the Glenview School zone has a guaranteed slot at the school. These children are deemed by the Ministry as '*first priority*'.

Any future out-of-zone child with a sibling currently attending Glenview School

These children are '*second priority*' and can be granted a slot at Glenview after the '*first priority*' (in zone) children have been provided a slot. A ballot will only be held if the number of these children exceeds the number of slots available – if the number of these children is less than the number of slots available, all these children will be given slots at Glenview.

These children do not have a guaranteed slot at Glenview and we are not able to provide such a guarantee. However, knowing our current enrolment numbers and learning from the experiences of other zoned schools, virtually always these children are provided a slot.

Any future out-of-zone child who is a sibling of a former student at Glenview

These children are '*third priority*' who, if any slots remain, can be granted a slot through a ballot (if needed), after the first and second priority children have been granted slots.

Any future out-of-zone child who has a parent who was a former student at Glenview

These children are '*fourth priority*'. If any slots remain, these children can be granted a slot though a ballot system (if needed), after the previous priority children have been granted slots.

Any future out-of-zone child who has a parent who is either a Glenview employee or Glenview School Board of Trustees member

These children are '*fifth priority*'. If any slots remain, these children can be granted a slot though a ballot system (if needed) after the previous priority children have been granted slots.

Any other out-of-zone child

These children are '*sixth priority*'. If any slots remain, these children can be granted a slot though a ballot system after the previous priority children have been granted slots.

How does the ballot system work?

Slots are first granted to the first priority children, followed by the second priority, followed by third, etc. A ballot is held within a priority cohort only if the number of applications from that cohort exceeds the number of available slots (i.e. exceeds the maximum capacity of the school).

Ballots will occur several times during the year. These dates will be advertised through the newspapers, local community bulleted points, and the school website.

Once a child have been given a slot at Glenview, this slot is guaranteed until the child has finished at Glenview.
