Last week the first Board of Trustees Mtg was held for the year. The board is the same as last year; Steve Cox Chairperson, Karsten Zegwaard Secretary, Maree Nobilo, Jo Stewart, Kylie Harcourt, Eliza Thompson and Cameron Old. Our School academic targets were confirmed for the year along with the school Charter which was sent to the Ministry on the 1st February. Also confirmed were the building/upgrading projects funded through the Ministry. This year the Board is upgrading Rooms 7,8 and 9. These rooms will be modernized in line with the ministry guidelines on Modern Learning Environments. As part of this project a separate toilet block to serve these classrooms will be built.

Another project confirmed is the removal of the school Dental Clinic which will allow us to upgrade the front of the school with funds raised by the PTA over the last year.
