Welcome parents / caregivers to Week 3 at Glenview this term!

As we move into the cooler and wetter terms of school I would like to remind parents of how we can best deal with drop off and pick up issues we have when the weather is wet.

During the holidays the BOT improved the parking for staff at school to free up areas on Bruce Avenue, as this is the area that cause most issues before and after school when it is wet. If you feel you have to leave your car we encourage you to **not leave it in the drop off zone** in front of the school as this encourages double parking which then restricts the flow of traffic. I ask all parents to work with us to put children's safety as the first priority.

Yr 4-6 Student led Conferences

As mentioned last week we are hosting student led conferences with children in years 3-6 during week 6, 28-31 May. We are aware for some children in Yr 3-4 these will not apply if they have already had the 2 or 3 yr interview. For those parents whom it does apply there are three ways to book an interview with your child's teacher.

Online bookings opened on Monday. Those parents with access to a computer can book online by going to www.schoolinterviews.co.nz and following the online instructions. The event code is **NRK29** and this will give you access to the school booking schedule. When you click on your child's teacher you will be given their availability. If you do not have access to a computer you can fill out a booking slip and we will do the booking at school. Booking slips will be sent home this afternoon. You may fill one out at the office or your child's classroom. You may also do a phone booking by ringing the office after 9.30am. We will send confirmation of all interviews.

It is acknowledged that a strong partnership between parents and teachers is important for children's on going learning. It is important that all parents attend these interviews. If for some reason you are not able to attend during week six please contact your child's teacher.
