## ***Welcome parents / caregivers to Week 6 at Glenview this term!.***

This term the Board approached the Hamilton City Council regarding the traffic situation on Bruce Avenue before and after school. ( Many schools are having similar issues and are working with the Council). After meeting with representatives from the Council they have agreed to shorten the 10 minute drop off zone ( at the front of the school) to 2 minutes. This will hopefully stop parents from leaving their cars there. They will also create 7 car parks (with a 2 minute zone ) in front of Glenview Park close to the school. This will hopefully stop the double parking at the laybuy zone in front of the school. The Council are in the process of notifying residents it may affect and asking for feedback on this proposal.

As a school we can only see the benefit of making Bruce Avenue a safer place for children before and after school.

### **Parent survey**

The Board have finalised the questionnaire. An outline of the questionnaire will appear in the newsletter before the children bring a copy of the questionnaire home for parents to fill out. This will happen towards the end of the term. Getting a large number of responses back assists the Board when reviewing school policy and procedures. Having a wide parent perspective is important when making decisions that may impact on your child/ren's education at Glenview.

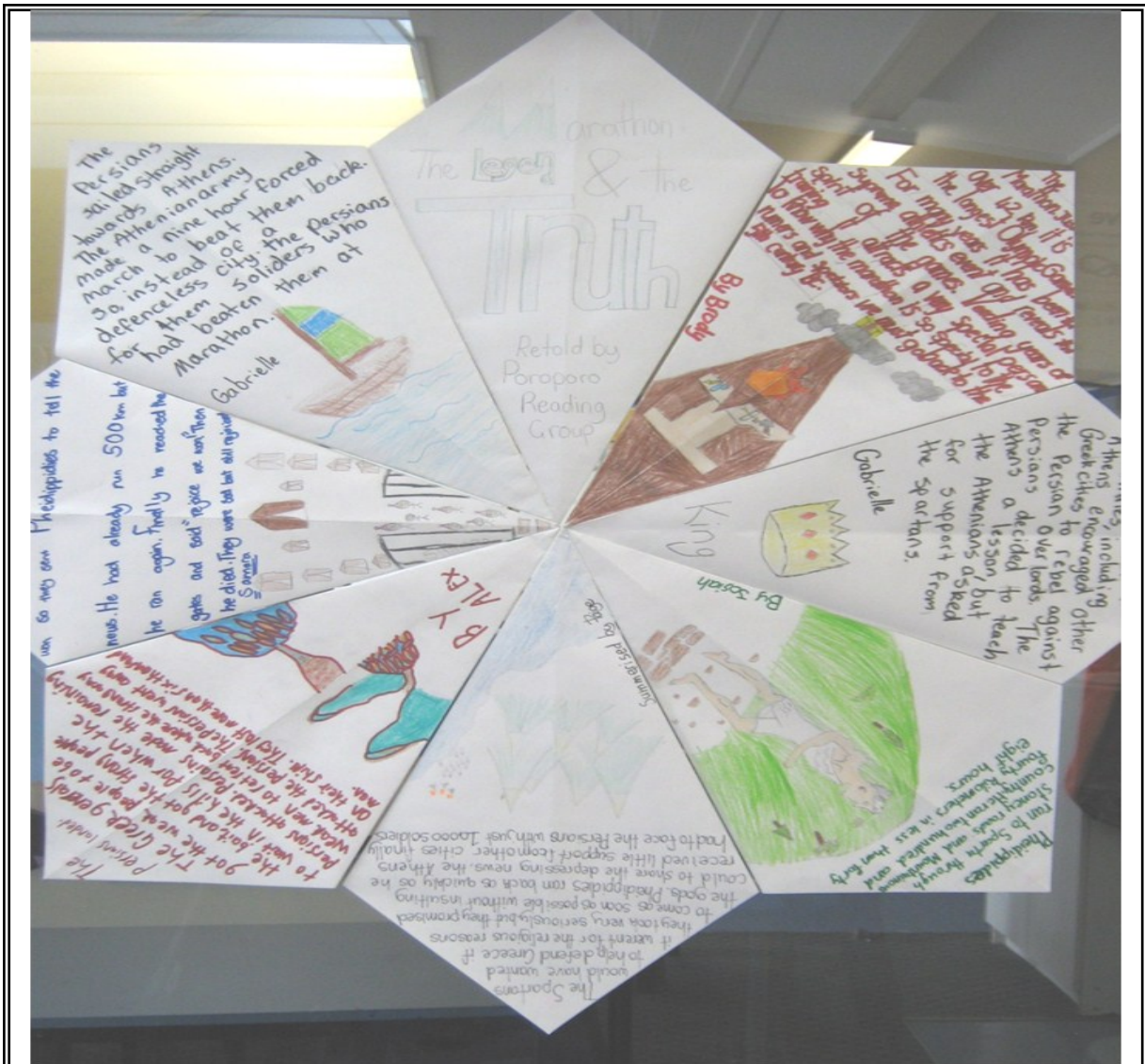
