This is the only way we can make sure all families have an opportunity to attend the shows. There may be tickets that have not been sold and these will be offered for general sale from Thursday 20th September (week 10). (First in, first served basis when we know how many are left over.)

We understand that some families may have children spread out over 2 or more syndicates. If you have children in 2 or more show's there will be a concession ticket available.

If you are unable to purchase tickets for the night performance, please feel welcome to attend the daily matinee/full dress rehearsal's which are offered at a gold coin donation, these performances will be just as fabulous!

Please be aware, so there are no disappointments, there are strictly NO door sales on the night performances. You must provide your ticket at the door entrance.
