Welcome parents / caregivers to Week 2 at Glenview this term!

School Parking

Last week the council changed the parking zone at the front of the school. To improve the traffic movement and safety around the school the council have created two "Drop off" zones on Bruce Avenue. The existing parking bay in front of the school has gone from a 10 minute zone to a 2 minute zone. **This is to discourage parents leaving their car when dropping children off.** The council have also created a 2 minute zone in front of Glenview Park. This is to encourage parents to drive past the first zone if no place is available and use the second area to drop children off. These changes should result in no need for parents to be double parked in these areas.

Another traffic concern brought to our attention is the increasing number of parents using the intersection of Bruce Avenue and Jeanette street as a convenient place to do a u turn. As we have an increasing number of children crossing at the Jeanette Street intersection it is becoming quite dangerous. We are meeting with the council next week to see if there is a resolution to this situation. At all times we have the safety of children in mind.
