Welcome parents / caregivers to Week 3 at Glenview this term!

Thank you parents for finalising your child's stationery so they can start the year ready to go.

Thankyou to the year 5 and 6 parents who have volunteered their time to be camp parents at Waitawheta this year. Our camp programme relies heavily on parent support to happen so thank you all.

Apart from our usual school events we have two important events that are happening this year. Firstly we are hosting Education Review Officers this term. They visit most schools every three years to review how the school is meeting the needs of the community. They will be visiting Glenview School during the week of the 18th of March. They will be in the school for about 4 days. During this time they would like to meet with parents. As we get closer to the time I will inform you of the time and day.

Secondly, this year is Board of Trustees Elections. The actual election happens at the end of May. Our Board is made up of seven parent representatives. I would like to thank our parents for making the effort with hats. It is great to see our children becoming sunsafe.

Child Safety Issues (A gentle reminder)

Child safety to and from school is very important. However there are some practices often with parent approval which we see putting children at risk. As you are aware we run 2 Kea Crossings one on Bruce Ave and one on Lewis Street. These are manned by our senior students who give up their time to do a fantastic service for the school. **It is then disappointing when we see parents when bringing their child/ren to school crossing the road within sight of the crossings.** The other practice that concerns us is the vehicle access to the park next to the Chinese hall being used as a pedestrian lane. Again this is often used by parents who want to avoid using the crossing. If we want our children to be safe we need to lead by example.

School Attendance

It is very important that children attend school every day. The Ministry aim for 96% attendance. If your child is absent please ring the absence line and leave a message. The number appears later in this newsletter.
