Year 3-6 Student Led Conferences

We are hosting student led conferences with children in years 3-6, Week 6 Monday 25 and Tuesday 26 August. This year there is a change in the format, we have done this to give children/parents more time to discuss their work. When you book an interview, you will see four spaces within each 30 minute time period. This means there will be up to four interviews happening in the class at the one time. The teacher will be roaming at this time to assist with any queries.

There are three ways to book an interview with your child's teacher.

Online bookings open Thursday 7th August. Those parents with access to a computer can book online, by going to www.schoolinterviews.co.nz and following the online instructions.

The event code is **TPJME** which will give you access to the booking schedule.

If you do not have access to a computer you can fill out a booking slip and we will do the booking at school. Booking slips will be sent home on Wednesday 6 August for you to fill out. There will also be some available at the classroom or the office.

We will send confirmation of all interviews.

It is acknowledged that a strong partnership between parents and teachers is important for children's on going learning. This is an opportunity to view your child's portfolio. If for some reason you are not able to attend during week 6 please contact your child's teacher.
