SCHOOL DONATION:

You will have found attached to your children's stationery order, a request for the school donation. Even though we are funded from the Ministry, many of the extras we offer children, (e.g. Interactive Whiteboards, library books, sports equipment and sports uniforms etc.) come from locally raised funds from P.T.A. fundraising, Community Grants and School donations. At \$60 for 1 child and \$110 for a family, our donation is at the lower end. However it is an important part of our local fundraising.

ANNUAL CONSENT FORM:

All children will be bringing home an annual consent form this week which covers a range of activities and programmes that children may be involved in throughout the year. When the agreement comes home, please sign and return promptly so that your children can begin being involved with these activities.

STATIONERY:

Your children should have brought home a stationery order which lists their requirements for this year. As we use a particular brand of stationery that has different sizes from regular brands, it is important that children **buy their stationery from the school**. We have sourced stationery that we consider good quality and stands up to constant daily use. Kay and her helpers will be selling stationery during this week. As the children will come to the staffroom in class groups, we won't be selling stationery before school until the following week.

SCHOOL LUNCHES:
