Welcome parents / caregivers to Week 2 at Glenview!

We have enjoyed a smooth start to Term 3, thank you for supporting your children to enable this to happen.

This week the contractors will do the final touches to the astro turf. The contractors will also be removing the temporary road and reinstating the park grounds. We can expect heavy truck movements in the next few days as they remove the base course and metal and bring back the topsoil. So I ask parents who use the back entrance to be extra careful in the next few days.

When the turf is finally handed over Staff from Sports Waikato will be taking every class through a programme showing teachers activities they can use on the turf.

Last week we cut up the materials for our garden area at the front of the school. Over the next couple of weeks we hope to finish constructing the gardens and then filling them with soil and compost ready for the spring planting season. If any parents are able to assist us in the next couple of weeks to do any of this work feel free to contact the office.

Sports photos are being held on the 30th of August. Children will be bringing home an envelope in the next couple of days.
