They have informed me that weather permitting they hope to be able to get the first seal down this week. They are also putting down cement to help stabilize the surface and you will need to wash it off your car if it splashes onto the car. Until then, traffic will not be allowed to park on the sides of the road.

To assist the contractors they have requested that parents continue to use an alternative route for picking and dropping off children before and after school. The Lewis Street entrances will be suitable for this. The footpaths will be open both sides of the road so children can also be dropped off outside the work area and walk.
